

# MVHS IB School Community Expectations and Requirements

## **IB Diploma Student Requirements for 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade:**

- ✓ Complete courses in each of the required six academic subject groups, plus Theory of Knowledge, and complete the six culminating exams. Students must take 3 “standard level” courses (150 hours), and 3 “higher level (240)” courses.
- ✓ Write an Extended Essay of 3,500-4,000 words (due in the senior year).
- ✓ Complete 16 months of Creativity, Action, Service, along with reflection that demonstrate the 8 CAS Learning outcomes.
- ✓ Receive internal and external assessment marks totaling between 24 and 45.
- ✓ Students may not receive a “fail” in any course, nor may they earn an exam score of 2 or below.
- ✓ Be motivated, diligent, well-organized, and have academic integrity.

## **IB Certificate Student Requirements:**

- ✓ Complete one or more IB courses, including all internal assessments.
- ✓ Write the IB exam(s) for the chosen IB courses.
- ✓ Be motivated, diligent, well-organized, and have academic integrity.

## **IB Diploma Teacher Requirements:**

- ✓ Follow IB Diploma requirements for internal and external assessments.
- ✓ Provide students with rigorous coursework and assessments that are outlined in the IB Diploma framework for each subject area.
- ✓ Provide predicted grades to the IBO.
- ✓ Collaborate with other IB Diploma teachers to enrich interdisciplinary connections and provide support for students and teachers.

## **IB Diploma School Requirements:**

- ✓ Support the IB program financially and through school policies.
- ✓ Provide the resources necessary to administer the Diploma program.
- ✓ Educate students, parents and teachers about the requirements and value of the IB Diploma program.
- ✓ Provide general and subject area training to all teachers about the program.
- ✓ Provide time for collaboration.
